- **3.** Be credit-worthy and have the required credit score, or have a co-signer who meets the credit requirements.
- 4. Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Meet other federal student eligibility requirements as certified by the student's school.
- 6. Be in good standing on any other CFI loan(s).
